### Faceted Search

It is a new spin on parametric search and taxonomy-based search. For any search that you perform, you are proactively shown a summary of the number of matches grouped together for your search for specific values. Zooming on each group, your search is re-run against that specific subset of data. This allows you to "drill down" through results, getting more and more specific. Field values or attributes that produce no results are not shown. And any constraint can be easily removed from the search, to open it back up to more documents.

### Automatic Clustering

It organizes search results into groups, gathering matching pieces of data from numerous sources without the need for predefined taxonomies or manual tags. By automatically collecting and ordering information as it becomes available, the technology instantly identifies hot topics and unveils relationships between pieces of content that might otherwise have remained unnoticed. The factor that makes **nautilus** an indispensable tool for the enterprise lies in its ability to identify information clusters fully automatically, without the need for users to predefine categories.

## Technical Information

### Key Features

#### Search

- Search and Browsing available through fast Ajax web interface
- Search for keywords or phrases.
- Incremental search
- Grouping of search results for any available metadata
- Automatic clustering

- Search for documents by date or by special fields as title, location, author, etc.
- Employs powerful query syntax to search for documents including Boolean and other search operators (AND, OR, NOT, NEAR) and quotes.
- Search using the wild-card characters \* and ?
- Search for specific custom metadata and XML data.
- Restrict searches to specific groups of information sources to improve relevancy.

#### Indexing

- Supports crawling of different type of sources: Web (HTTP/HTTPS), local file systems, remote file systems (SMB), FTP, Gopher, email (POP3/IMAP4), Newsgroups (NNTP), Webdav, RSS feeds, Databases (ODBC).
- Supports most popular file formats: HTML pages, Microsoft Word documents, Adobe PDF files, Rich Text Format documents, XML documents
- Automatically detects document language (English, French, German, Spanish, Dutch, Italian and Portuguese).
- Groups multiple information sources into collections for categorization by subject or field of interest.
- Queries run concurrently with index updates: no downtime when updating your data.
- Refresh each information source according to a specified schedule.
- Includes or excludes documents by URL using the regular expression syntax.
- Indexes relational databases.
- Delivers advanced fault tolerance and recovery architecture to ensure everlasting index integrity.
- Features high performance multi-threading crawling.
- Complies with the crawler exclusion standards (robots.txt).
- Can crawl through a proxy server.
- Configured to crawl sources with digital certificate
- Supports crawling HTTP sources that use cookies for authentication.
- Can use username/password authentication with all the protocols supporting it.
- Automatically assigns different weights to different portion of a document depending on layout characteristics.

#### Security

- Restrict information sources to specific users
- Saves username and password and/or digital certificates for subsequent indexing of protected sources

- Provides installation wizard for quick and easy implementation
- Offers a user-friendly Ajax application for system administration.
- Generates extensive reports about index contents, queries, crawlers, PlugIns and system operations.
- Allows backups and index optimization.
